## Senior Enlisted Blended Seminar (SEBS)

#### What is the Senior Enlisted Blended Seminar?

- The Senior Enlisted Blended Seminar (SEBS) will be the required PME for Marines in the grade of E8, for both Master Sergeants and First Sergeants.
- SEBS will be run at the four major SNCO Academies: Camp Pendleton, Quantico, Camp Lejeune, and Okinawa. Marines will attend the academy closest to them.
- SEBS will consist of 8 weeks of synchronous, seminar style learning, called the Non Resident Seminar (NRS) during off duty hours, where Marines are required to meet weekly with the instructor.
- The resident portion of the SEBS will be 2 weeks long, during duty hours, called the Final Resident Seminar (FRS).
- SEBS will provide instruction on Warfighting, Joint Operations and Planning, Leadership, Professional Ethics, and Communication.

### When will the SEBS replace the current E8 PME requirement?

- The SEBS is still in the pilot phase.
- The E8 Seminar, as it now exists, will continue until all the conditions are met at each of the regional academies to conduct the SEBS.

## Why is the SEBS replacing the E8 Seminar?

• The E8 Seminar was not providing the educational rigor necessary to prepare master sergeants and first sergeants for their role as Senior Enlisted Advisors.

### What is Blended in the Blended Seminar?

SEBS combines virtual and resident education to meet the course requirements.

## Am I "PME Complete" after completing the SEBS?

- If you are a master sergeant, you have met the PME requirement for promotion.
- If you are a first sergeant, you will need to complete both the SEBS and the First Sergeant School to meet the PME requirement for promotion.

#### Is the SEBS TECOM funded?

No, parent commands are responsible for funding travel, lodging and rental vehicles.

# What type of orders will I need?

- Temporary additional duty is not authorized for the NRS period of the SEBS
- Funded, non-reporting orders are required for the FRS period of the SEBS.

#### What do I need for the course?

- An open mind and willingness to learn.
- Personal computer with audio and video capability and internet access.
- Laptop or tablet device for use while attending the SEBS; printed material will not be provided.

# What if I already completed the E8 Seminar?

• If you have completed the E8 Seminar, you are considered "PME complete". You will not be required to complete the SEBS.
