REDESIGNATED 24 AUGUST 1944 AS PROVISIONAL HEADQUARTERS AND SERVICE BATTALION, FLEET MARINE FORCE, PACIFIC

FORMALLY DESIGNATED 17 SEPTEMBER 1944 AS HEADQUARTERS AND SERVICE BATTALION, FLEET MARINE FORCE, PACIFIC

RELOCATED DURING MAY 1950 TO PEARL HARBOR, TERRITORY OF HAWAII

RELOCATED DURING JANUARY 1956 TO CAMP H. M. SMITH, TERRITORY OF HAWAII
