REASSIGNED DURING AUGUST 1941 TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 11, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING AND RELOCATED TO CAMP MITCHELL, NEW BERN, NORTH CAROLINA

RELOCATED DURING DECEMBER 1941 TO QUANTICO, VIRGINIA, AND THEN TO SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA

DEACTIVATED 28 FEBRUARY 1942 AT SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA

REACTIVATED 1 MARCH 1942 AT SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, AS MARINE FIGHTING SQUADRON 121 AND ASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 12, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

REASSIGNED DURING AUGUST 1942 TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 14, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

DEPLOYED DURING SEPTEMBER 1942 TO THE SOUTH PACIFIC

REDESIGNATED 1 APRIL 1949 AS MARINE FIGHTER SQUADRON 121

RELOCATED DURING APRIL 1951 TO EL TORO, CALIFORNIA, AND RETURNED TO ACTIVE DUTY

REASSIGNED DURING APRIL 1951 TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 13, AIR, FLEET MARINE FORCE, PACIFIC

REDESIGNATED 15 MAY 1951 AS MARINE ATTACK SQUADRON 121 AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 13,
FLEET MARINE FORCE, PACIFIC

REASSIGNED DURING OCTOBER 1951 TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 13, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

DEPLOYED DURING OCTOBER 1951 TO KOREA AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 33,

DEPLOYED DURING NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER 1962 TO FLORIDA IN CONNECTION WITH THE CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS

1970 – 2006

RELOCATED DURING JUNE 1978 TO EL TORO, CALIFORNIA, AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 13,
3D MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

RELOCATED DURING JUNE 1994 TO MIRAMAR, CALIFORNIA


