- 1. THE MCU, MARINE AIR-GROUND TRAINING AND EDUCATION CENTER, AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE MARINE CORPS CONBAT DEVELOPMENT COMMAND (MCCDC) GUANTICO, VA WILL BE ACTIVATED EFFECTIVE 1 AUG 89.
- 2. BACKGROUND. DN 3 MAY 88, THE MARINE AIR-GROUND TRAINING AND EDUCATION CENTER WAS ESTABLISHED TO CONSCLIDATE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE TRAINING DEPARTMENT, HQMC, WITH THOSE OF THE EDUCATION CENTER AND ELEMENTS OF THE TRAINING, AUDIO-VISUAL AND GAMING SUPPORT CENTER AT MCCDC. ON 10 NOV 88, THE REF ANNOUNCED THAT A NEW PROGRAM OF MANDATORY, CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION (PME) WAS BEING DEVELOPED FOR ALL MARINE LEADERS, CORPORAL THROUGH GENERAL. IN ORDER TO SUCCESSFULLY IMPLEMENT AND MANAGE THE NEW PME PROGRAM, IT WAS DETERMINED THAT AN ORGANIZATION SHOULD BE ESTABLISHED TO SERVE AS THE FCCAL POINT FOR PME WITHIN THE MARINE CORPS. THAT CRGANIZATION WILL BE THE MCU.
- 3. MISSION. THE MISSION OF THE MCU IS TO DEVELOP, RECOMMEND, IMPLEMENT, AND MONITOR THE RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT PME POLICIES AND PROGRAMS FOR ALL MARINES, ACTIVE AND RESERVE.
- THE MCU IS. ESTABLISHED TO STRENGTHEN AND ENHANCE OUR PME PROCESS BY PROVICING A PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION SYSTEM DESIGNED TO IMPART A COMMON BASE OF PROFESSIONAL KNOWLEDGE THROUGHOUT OUR CORPS. THE SYSTEM WILL PROVIDE FOR A PROGRESSIVE AND SEQUENTIAL PROCESS WHICH WILL INCLUDE THE ANALYSIS AND DEVELOPMENT OF PME COMPETENCIES APPROPRIATE TO THE GRADE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE INDIVIDUAL MARINE. THE MCU WILL PROVIDE AN INTEGRATED, WORLDWIDE, PME NETWORK AND INTEGRATE THE MARINE CORPS INSTITUTE AND MARINE CORPS RESEARCH
