The President of the United States takes pleasure in presenting the MEDAL OF HONOR posthumously to FIRST LIBUTENANT GEORGE H. CANNON, USMC

for services as set forth in the following

CITATION:

"For distinguished conduct in the line of his profession, extraordinary courses, and disregard of his own condition during the benbardment of Midway Island, by Japsness forces. Liquitenant Cannon was at his Command Fostwhen he was mortally wounded by enemy shell fire. He refused to be evacuated from his post until after his mon who had been wounded by the same shell, were evacuated, and directed the reorganization of his Command Fost until foreibly removed and as a result of his dutter disregard of his own condition, he died from loss of blood.
