Dr. Elihu Rose Award for Teaching Excellence

Functional Lead: Provost

Division: Academic Support Division

Responsible Office: Registrar

1. Purpose. This policy defines the processes for the Rose Award for Teaching Excellence.

- 2. Background. Each year the President, Marine Corps University (MCU), in coordination with the Marine Corps University Foundation, presents the Dr. Elihu Rose Award for Teaching Excellence to MCU's most outstanding educators to recognize excellence in teaching. The Rose Award is named after Dr. Elihu Rose, a MCU Foundation founding member.
- 3. Policy. Schools will nominate faculty members who exhibit the highest standards of excellence in teaching and incorporate the most effective teaching methodologies that enhance student learning within their course. For the resident programs one award will be given to a civilian faculty member, one award to an officer faculty member, and one award to an enlisted faculty member. For the distance programs, one award will be given to a faculty member of each of the three distance programs. Selection committees convened as below and consisting of the educational program deans and chief academic officers, or their designated representatives, review all nominations and determine the Rose Award recipient for each category.

4. Procedures

- a. Program directors will forward all nominations to the University Registrar.
 - (1) For officer and enlisted resident programs, the Provost will convene the panel.
- (2) For distance programs, the Director of the College of Distance Education and Training will convene the panel.
 - (3) The University Registrar will maintain a record of the results of each panel.
- b. The MCU Provost will recognize the winners at the annual MCU awards ceremony. Dr. Rose is invited to the awards presentation ceremonies each year.
- c. Each year, the Provost will publish the nomination procedures and supporting documentation via separate letter of instruction.
