COLLEGES AND SCHOOLS

University programs graduating in AY25:

Marine Corps War College

MCWAR provides a eleven-month resident program to educate selected senior officers and civilians for decision-making across the range of military operations in a joint, interagency, and multinational environment. Graduates are prepared to assume senior leadership positions of increasing complexity through the study of national military strategy, theater strategy and plans, and military support to those strategies within the context of national security policies, decision- making, objectives, and resources. Graduates who meet admission requirements earn the University's Master of Strategic Studies degree.

School of Advanced Warfighting

SAW provides an eleven-month course designed to amplify and complement the curriculum provided at the Command and Staff College. This follow-on course for select intermediate level school graduates focuses on developing decision-making skills and complex problem-solving abilities at the operational level. Graduates are certified as Marine Air-Ground Task Force Planners and earn the University's Master of Operational Studies degree.

Command and Staff College

CSC provides a ten-month course that educates and trains joint, multinational, and interagency professionals in order to produce skilled warfighting leaders able to overcome diverse 21st century security challenges. Those students who apply and meet the requirements for the degree program also earn the University's Master of Military Studies degree.

College of Distance Education and Training

CDET provides a worldwide Marine Corps network that supports the professional growth of students through Distance Education with an emphasis on warfighting, leadership, and battle-staff employment, in both joint and multinational environments, at the tactical, operational and strategic levels of warfare.

MCU HISTORY

Marine Corps University was founded on 1 August 1989, by order of the Commandant of the Marine Corps, General Alfred M. Gray, Jr. Its schools claim a much longer history, beginning in 1891 with 29 company grade officers attending the School of Application. Today's MCU is the legacy of visionary leaders of the Marine Corps: Generals John A. Lejeune, Smedley D. Butler, James C. Breckinridge, and Alfred M. Gray. The understanding of the demands of military leadership provided the drive that culminated in the establishment of Marine Corps University.

Since the founding of the School of Application in 1891 – the first resident school for Marine Corps officers – MCU has evolved and expanded to meet the emerging needs of a mobile, warfighting force. By 1921, the framework for what General John Lejeune termed the "Marine Corps Schools" was established through the creation of the Field Officers Course and the Company Grade Officers course. The commitment to amphibious warfare provided the impetus behind the development of Marine Corps science, eventually leading to the establishment of the Amphibious Warfare School. The Senior Course developed into what is now Command and Staff College, and the Junior Course became the Amphibious Warfare School, now called Expeditionary Warfare School.

The establishment of the Marine Corps War College, an academy for senior-level strategic skill development, and the emergence of the School of Advanced Warfighting, which specializes in developing superior operational planning experts, completed the University's complement of schools for Officer Professional Military Education.

While preserving the legacy of this great tradition, MCU maintains the highest level of academic excellence as proven by Joint Professional Military Education and regional accreditation by the Joint Staff and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.

The Marine Corps is poised on the foundation of our history, moving with confidence into a new era. MCU seeks engagement with those who share our vision of creating visionary leaders who are capable of shaping the world through the power of dynamic leadership and bold ideas.

LtGen Watson graduated from Cornell University in 1991 and was commissioned through the NROTC program. After The Basic School and Infantry Officer Course, he reported to 3rd Battalion, 8th Marine Regiment, in Camp Lejeune, NC, where he served as a Platoon Commander and Executive Officer with Company K, including deployments with the 24th and 26th MEU(SOC).

LtGen Watson's other operational assignments include: Commanding Officer, Weapons Company, and Operations Officer, 2nd Battalion, 6th Marines, from 1999-2002, including deployments with the 22nd and 24th MEU(SOC) in support of Operations Provide Promise and Deny Flight in and around the former Yugoslavia, and Operation Dynamic Response in Kosovo; G-3 Future Operations Planner, I Marine Expeditionary Force (Forward), from 2006-2007 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, including service with Regimental Combat Team-7; G-3 Plans Officer, 1st Marine Division, from 2007-2008; Commanding Officer, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, from 2008-2011, including deployments with 31st MEU and to Garmsir District, Helmand Province, Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom; Assistant Division Commander, 2nd Marine Division, from 2016-2017; and Commanding General (CG), Task Force Southwest in Helmand and Nimroz Provinces, Afghanistan, from January to November 2018 in support of Operation Resolute Support and Operation Freedom's Sentinel. From 2022-2024, LtGen Watson commanded the 1st Marine Division.

His service outside the operating forces includes duty as an instructor at The Basic School from 1995-1997, the Infantry Officer Course from 1997-1998, and the Expeditionary Warfare School from 2002-2005. From 2012-2013, he served in the Office of the Secretary of Defense as Senior Military Assistant to the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Asian & Pacific Security Affairs. From 2013-2014, he was assigned to the Office of the Secretary of Defense as Special Assistant to the Chief of Staff. LtGen Watson served as the Commanding Officer of Marine Barracks, Washington D.C. (8th & I), from 2014-16. From 2018-2019, he served as the CG of Marine Corps Installations East / Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, and from 2019-2022 as CG of the Marine Corps Warfighting Laboratory / Futures Directorate and Vice Chief of the Office of Naval Research. In August of 2024, LtGen Watson assumed duties as CG, Training & Education Command.

LtGen Watson is a graduate of the Marine Corps Summer Mountain Leaders Course, Amphibious Warfare School, Marine Corps Command & Staff College (Non-Resident), Marine Corps School of Advanced Warfighting (Masters - Military Operational Studies), and the National War College (Masters - National Security Studies).

Lieutenant General Watson's personal decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal with "C" (2), Legion of Merit, Bronze Star with "V," Meritorious Service Medal (2), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (3), and Combat Action Ribbon (2).

Colonel Mark R. Reid currently serves as EDCOM/MCU Chief of Staff.

He was commissioned in June 1996 through the Naval Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York.

Previous operational assignments include: 2d Battalion, 8th Marines; 3d Battalion, 8th Marines; 1st Battalion, 25th Marines; Headquarters Group, II Marine Expeditionary Force; Combined Joint Special Operations Task Force-Afghanistan, and U.S. Marine Corps Forces Special Operations Command in commander, operations officer, executive officer, and staff officer billets. During these assignments, Colonel Reid deployed to the Caribbean, northeast Asia, South America, Africa, the Levant, and Afghanistan in support of security cooperation programs and Operations NEW HORIZON, IRAQI FREEDOM, and ENDURING FREEDOM.

Previous supporting establishment assignments include: Inspector-Instructor, 25th Marines; School of Infantry (East); Training and Education Command; Weapons Training Battalion, Stone Bay, NC; and Headquarters and Service Battalion, Fleet Marine Force Atlantic/U.S. Marine Corps Forces Command/ U.S. Marine Corps Forces Northern Command in commanding officer, executive officer, operations officer, and staff officer billets.
