The Officer Block 4 (OB4) curriculum, for majors and chief warrant officers 4, and the Enlisted Block 5 (EB5) curriculum, for gunnery sergeants, have been revised and the RCLF regions aligned to their respective combatant commands. The new OB4/EB5 curriculum will be activated on MarineNet no later than 31 May 2018. Marines currently enrolled in any regions OB4 or EB5 curriculum will receive an automated notice via email from MarineNet and will have until 30 June 2018 to finish the old curriculum before being automatically disenrolled. Partial completion of the old OB4 or EB5 curriculum will not be transferred towards completing the new curriculum. Marines who have completed the old version of the OB4 RCLF curriculum will still be considered as RCLF Complete in grade without having to complete the newly updated curriculum.
