Leaders,

Congratulations on your selection and upcoming attendance of First Sergeant Course 3-21. Please follow the enclosed directions and call should you have any questions.

I am looking forward to meeting each of you. We are the senior enlisted leaders of the Marine Corps. We have a duty and obligation to support our commanders in the successful execution of their duties, regardless of the element of the MAGTF to which you are assigned.

This course is very time intensive. We expect you to follow through with the many details of this letter and its enclosures. It is your responsibility to clear your calendar of other commitments during their duration.

Your official travel day is 20 June 2021. The first day of class is 21 June 2021.

Course Dates/Times:

Check-in: All attendees will be in the Woodland Marine Corps Combat Utility Uniform at Lecture Hall, located on the third floor of Warner Hall.

• Course Check-in: 0700-0745 on 21 June 2021

• Course Start: 0800 on 21 June 2021

• Course Graduation: 1230 on 02 July 2021

Note: No attendees will be released early from graduation to make a flight. Plan return flights with travel and traffic in mind.

Location of the Course:

Lecture Hall one, Warner Hall, 3057 Morell Ave, Quantico, VA 22134

Funding: Travel/Per Diem is funded by Formal Schools Training Section (FSTS). Rental cars will not be funded; however, individual units are encouraged to authorize rental cars using unit appropriation data. World Wide Travel (WWT) will process all DTS orders three working days before the course start date.

Billeting Information: You must first attempt to make your reservations at Liversedge Hall; if no rooms are available, they will issue a statement of non-availability in the form of a 6-digit pin. Suppose they are booked to their maximum occupancy. In that case, you must next attempt to make reservations with The Inns of the Corps, Quantico (previously known as The Crossroads) before reserving a room at any other hotel off base - which needs to be reserved using CTO if possible. If Liversedge Hall does not have available rooms, it is your responsibility to obtain a statement of non-availability from Liversedge Hall upon arrival in Quantico. Contact information is listed below; make your reservations as soon as possible.

Note: If the attendee has already made reservations at another location other than Liversedge hall and they will not issue a letter of non-availability because a room has come available, immediately notify SEA staff. At no time should the attendee move locations.
