CHECK IN PROCEDURES

- Students will report in the Service "A" uniform
- Students should not report prior to the report date. If you are arriving from off-island, ensure that coordination is conducted via the academy Deputy Director at DSN: 457-2560 or (808) 257-2560 for BEQ spaces and transportation requirements.
- Students will report to the Staff Noncommissioned Officer Academy (SNCOA), Marine Corps Base Hawaii (MCBH), Bldg 224.
- Students will report between the hours of 0700-1200. Marines registered in MCTIMS that fail to report by 1200 will lose their seat in the course and a "stand-by" will be given that seat.
- Marines must have the following items with them during the check-in process:
 - o Original Orders
 - Command Screening Checklist (NAVMC 11580) with Battalion/Squadron Commander and Sergeant Major signature and Medical Officer/IDC signature and <u>stamp</u>
 - Printed copy of EPME 5000AA completion certificate
