Call for Submissions Marine Corps History and Expeditions with MCUP

Marine Corps University Press is currently accepting articles and proposals for two of its scholarly journals, *Marine Corps History* and *Expeditions with MCUP*, on the theme of:

The Economy and National Security in an Era of Great Power Competition

The editors are seeking articles on topics related to the impacts of economic issues on national defense and security, particularly as they relate to great powers engaged in long-term strategic competition.

Articles can cover these topics from along a broad spectrum of both contemporary and historical examples of technological innovation and development, weapons acquisition and deployment, military modernization, naval integration, and supply chain security. This can incorporate national efforts to maintain superiority in conventional weapons technology, to counter hybrid warfare and gray-zone tactics, to advance national security objectives through irregular warfare strategies and tactics, and to prepare for extended-length, large-scale conflict.

Articles can incorporate any era and highlight the perspective of any country but should come particularly from a perspective of how economic issues impact the development, refinement, and implementation of national security strategy during periods of great power competition. Examples from specific wars or conflicts are welcome, such as World War I, World War II, and the Cold War.

Marine Corps History and Expeditions with MCUP are peer-reviewed, scholarly journals. Article submissions should be 4,000–10,000 words, footnoted, and formatted according to the Chicago Manual of Style (17th edition). Junior faculty and advanced graduate students are encouraged to submit.
