Profile:

Major Harvey received his commission through the PLC Program. Major Harvey's initial operational assignment was with Second Battalion, Tenth Marines where he served as a Platoon Commander and Battery Executive Officer. During this time he deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM, serving as a Platoon Commander and Detachment Executive Officer for the Regimental Combat Team Six Security Force. Following this deployment, Major Harvey was selected to attach to the British 7th Armoured Brigade as a Fire Support Officer during Exercise MAPLE LION. Following his operational tour, Major Harvey was assigned to The Basic School, where he served as a Warfighting Instructor, Staff Platoon Commander, Battery Commander of Artillery Instructor Battery, and Company Commander of Warfighting Instructor Company. Major Harvey then attended Expeditionary Warfare School prior to returning to Second Battalion, Tenth Marines. While on his second operational assignment Major Harvey served as the Battalion Fire Support Officer for First Battalion, Sixth Marines and Battery Commander of HQ Battery for Second Battalion, Tenth Marines. Major Harvey was then assigned as the Fire Support Coordinator for Task Force Southwest 19.1 where he deployed again to Afghanistan in support of Operation FREEDOM'S SENTINEL. Following his redeployment, Major Harvey reported to Expeditionary Warfare School for duty as a Faculty Advisor.
