

OCCUPATIONAL FIELD EXPANSION COURSE



<u>Purpose</u>

To reinforce the education delivered during the curriculum and enhance the students' ability to blend the military art (education) with the military science (training) to **increase their proficiency in their primary MOS**.

Method

- The <u>Fall OFEC</u> period is one week in length and focuses on **refreshing and expanding the students' knowledge** within their individual MOS.
- The <u>Spring OFEC</u> period is three weeks in length and concentrates on further developing the students' MOS proficiency as they prepare to re-enter the Operating Forces.

Endstate

EWS graduates **demonstrate proficiency in their respective MOS** and effectively employ their MOS skillsets when planning the tactical operations of an integrated combined arms MAGTF.



MAGTF OPERATIONS ASHORE



<u>Purpose</u>

To educate students on the elements of the MAGTF through the lens of the Single Battle Concept using our Maneuver Warfare philosophy.

<u>Method</u>

Through a single scenario beginning with IPB, eight sub-courses consisting of C4I, ISR, Fires, Logistics, Aviation, MAGTF in the Offense, MAGTF in the Defense, and Expeditionary Landing Team are executed in iterations of 3-day rotations.

Endstate

EWS graduates will be able to integrate all warfighting functions and plan for the doctrinal employment of a combined arms MAGTF ashore through the use of expeditionary enablers to execute complex and distributed naval expeditionary operations.
