- 1. <u>Situation</u>. This Order constitutes the Initiating Directive for the Commandant's Request Mast Program.
- 2. Cancellation. Education Command Order 1700.1A.
- 3. <u>Mission</u>. To preserve the right of all service members to directly communicate grievances to or seek assistance from their Commanding Officers, as exercised through the formal process of Request Mast. Request Mast, as established in reference (a), Articles 0820 and 1151.1, and reference (b), paragraph 2805, includes both the right of the service member to communicate with the Commanding Officer (CO) per reference (f), or the Commanding General (CG), normally in person, and the requirement that the CO or CG consider the matter and personally respond to the service member requesting mast.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) <u>Commander's Intent</u>. This Order will be utilized by all service members of this command for the purpose of exercising Request Mast with the CG. This Order will be published and all personnel will be informed of its content.
