Subj: EXPANSION OF THE EXECUTIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM

Ref: (a) CJCSI 1800.01E

1. Green Letter 1-20 is cancelled.

- 2. The expanded Executive Education Program (EEP) establishes the requirement for General Officers, Senior Executives, and Command Senior Enlisted Leaders (GO/SES/CSEL) to continue participation in professional military education as part of an active professional life-long learning process.
- 3. The expanded EEP is structured to provide courses at the GO/SES/CSEL level that parallel the Joint Professional Military Education continuum as outlined in reference (a). In addition to specific Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff (J-7) managed courses, the expanded EEP provides selected leader executive courses from universities and executive learning centers across the country.
- 4. My intent is for every GO/SES/CSEL to complete at least one course from each learning area (Leadership, Joint Warfighting, and Functional/Regional) at each level of progression. Minimum participation is one course annually. Course assignment is accomplished through a deliberate slating process. Semi-annually, the Director, Lejeune Leadership Institute will solicit preferences of available courses. In coordination with Manpower & Reserve Affairs, the President, Marine Corps University will approve and notify individuals of their slated courses. - 5. I consider lifelong learning as a critical warfighting enabler and, as in all things, I expect GO/SES/CSEL to set the example. My expectation is that you are leading the way.
