1941 – 1945

PARTICIPATED IN THE DEFENSE OF CORREGIDOR, JANUARY-MAY 1942

CAPTURED BY ENEMY FORCES ON 6 MAY 1942 AND TEMPORARILY CEASED TO EXIST

REACTIVATED 1 FEBRUARY 1944 ON GUADALCANAL BY REDESIGNATION FROM 1ST RAIDER REGIMENT

ASSIGNED DURING APRIL 1944 TO 1ST PROVISIONAL BRIGADE

REASSIGNED DURING SEPTEMBER 1944 TO 6TH MARINE DIVISION

DEPLOYED DURING AUGUST 1953 TO CAMP NARA, JAPAN

RELOCATED DURING FEBRUARY 1955 TO KANEHOE BAY, TERRITORY OF HAWAII, AND ASSIGNED TO
1ST PROVISIONAL MARINE AIR-GROUND TASK FORCE

1965 – 1994
