NOTE.—Whenever any officer shall be employed in the command of a squadron on separate service, the allowance of rations shall be double, during the continuance of such command, and no longer; except in the case of the commanding officer of the Navy, whose allowance, while in service shall always be at the rate of sixteen rations per day, agreeable to an act of Congress, passed 25th February, 1799.

N. B. The Commandant of Marines receives in addition to his pay, eight dollars per month, for the forage of three horses. The Adjutant, Quartermaster, and Paymaster, three dollars per month, extra.
