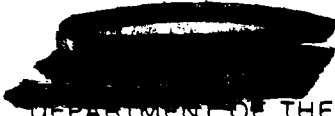

INFORMATION CURRENT AS OF 301600Z MAR 93CARIBBEAN(U) OPERATION GTMO

- INFORMATION CURRENT AS OF 242135Z MAR 93: - CURRENTLY THERE ARE 209 HIV(+) MIGRANTS AND 36 MEDICALLY CLEARED MIGRANTS. OF THE 36 MEDICALLY CLEARED 35 ARE HIV FAMILY MEMBERS.

- THE MIGRANT STATUS AS OF 242135Z MAR 93 (SATURATION LEVELS SHOWN IN PARENTHESIS): 230 AT CAMP BULKELEY (1120) (REDUCED FROM 1200 DUE TO MIGRANTS BURNING 12 SEA HUTS ON 13 MAR), 15 AT SEGRAGATION FACILITY (50), 0 AT THE GUANTANAMO BAY HOSPITAL AND 0 AT THE NAVBASE BRIG. (SEE DEPLOYED FORCES, PAGE B-6)

INDIAN OCEAN(U) OPERATION RESTORE HOPE

- CJTF-SOMALIA COMMANDERS COMMENTS; A DAY THAT COULD HAVE BEEN POTENTIALLY CHALLENGING TURNED OUT TO BE VERY BENIGN. IN MOGADISHU THE RALLY CONDUCTED AS A CELEBRATION OF THE SIGNING OF THE ADDIS ABABA ACCORDS WAS PEACEFUL AND UNEVENTFUL. THE GCE COMMANDER'S SURVEILLANCE PLAN WAS EFFECTIVE AND GAVE US A GOOD FEEL FOR THE MOOD OF THE CROWD. WITHOUT BEING INTRUSIVE. WE DEMONSTRATED OUR ABILITY TO DETECT AND RESPOND QUICKLY TO ANY ATYPICAL INCIDENT.

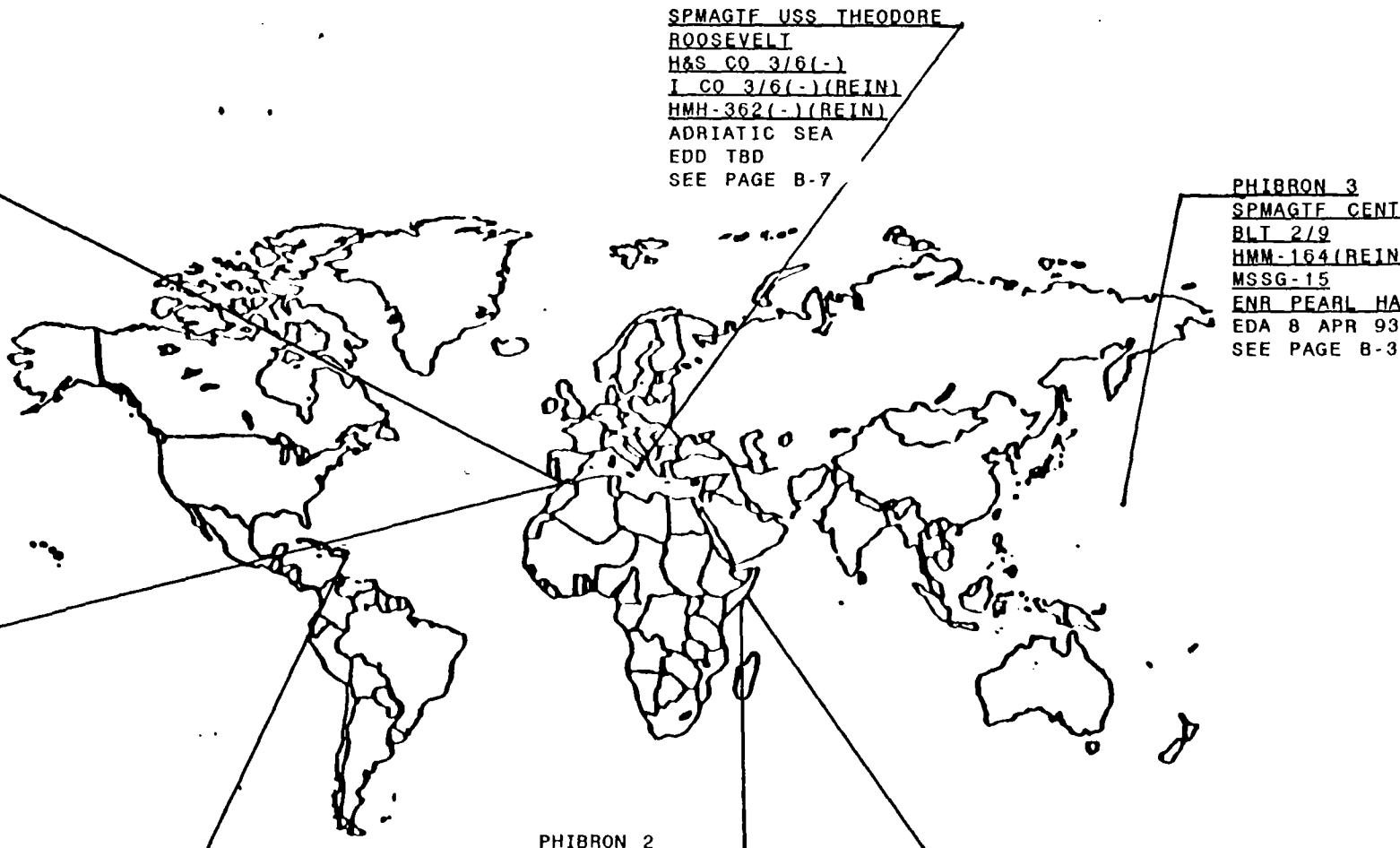

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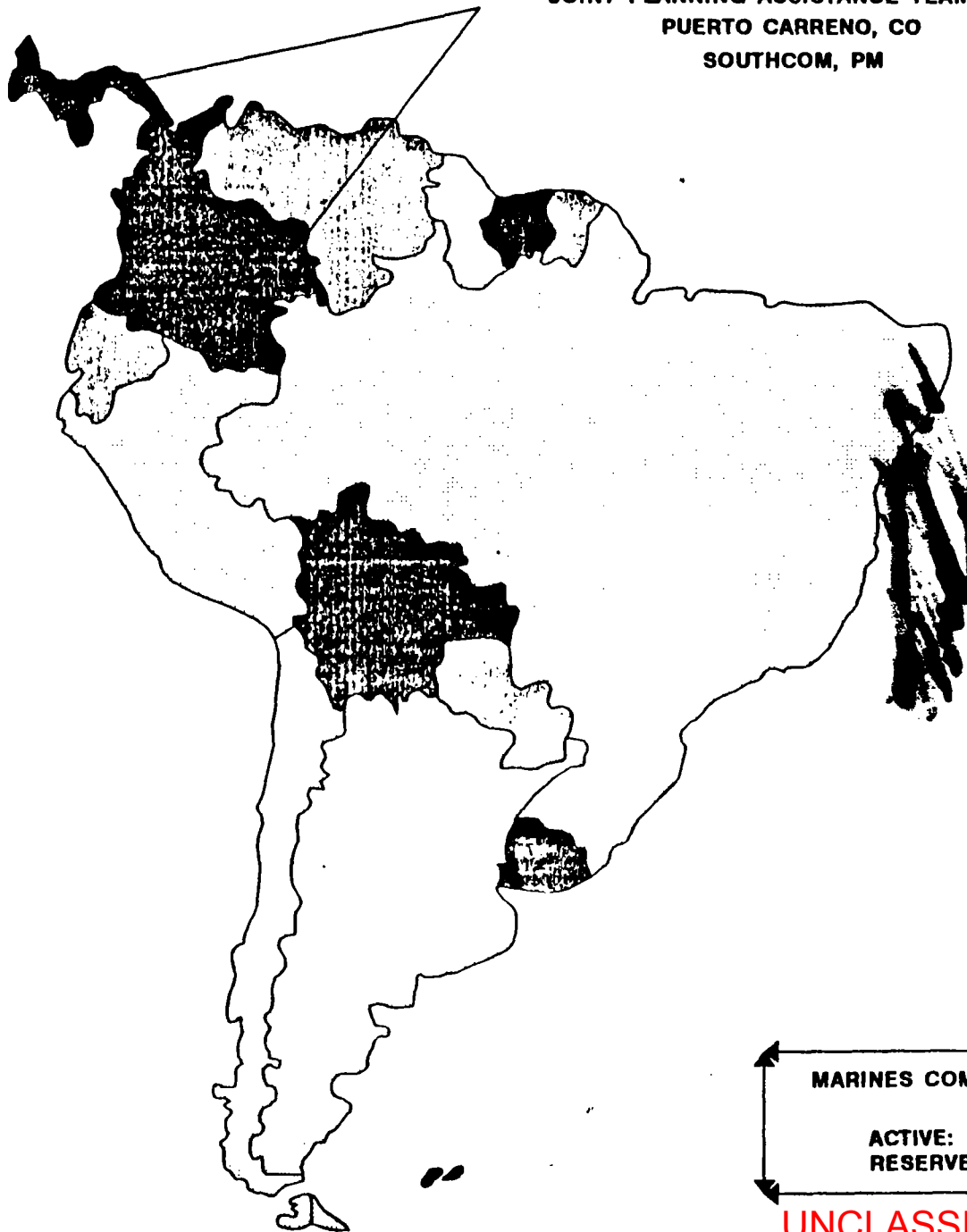

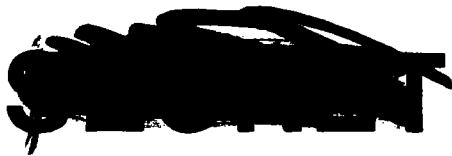
