(C) 15TH MEU(SOC)/TRIPOLI ARG

- 15TH MEU(SOC)/USS TRIPOLI AND THE USS CLEVELAND ARE MODLOC VIC OF MOMBASA, KENYA. THEY CONTINUE THE SOMALIA NEO CONTINGENCY RESPONSIBILITIES. THE USS FORT MCHENRY IS ENR TO JORDAN TO PARTICIPATE IN INFINITE MOONLIGHT 94-1, A USMC/JORDANIAN ARMY FIELD TRAINING EXERCISE. THE USS RUSHMORE WILL JOIN THE ARG APPROX 26 AUG. DET, HMH-466 HAS TRANSFERRED OPCON TO USCINCEUR. (SEE DEPLOYED FORCES, PAGES B-6 AND B-10)
