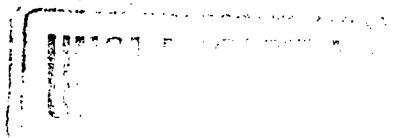

INFORMATION CURRENT AS OF 301800Z NOV 92CARIBBEAN(U) OPERATION GTMO

- INFORMATION CURRENT AS OF 231848Z NOV 92: - CURRENTLY THERE ARE 223 HIV(+) MIGRANTS AND 53 MEDICALLY CLEARED. OF THE 53 MEDICALLY CLEARED 52 ARE HIV FAMILY MEMBERS.

- THE MIGRANT STATUS AS OF 231848Z NOV 92 (SATURATION LEVELS SHOWN IN PARENTHESIS): 276 AT CAMP BULKELEY (1200) AND 0 AT THE GUANTANAMO BAY HOSPITAL. THERE ARE A TOTAL OF 276 HAITIANS AT GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA. THROUGH 31 JAN 92, THERE WERE 955 MIGRANTS REPATRIATED TO HAITI (417 VOLUNTARY AND 538 INVOLUNTARY (PRIOR TO THE TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER)); SINCE 1 FEB 92, THERE HAVE BEEN 26,958 MIGRANTS REPATRIATED TO HAITI (23,880 FROM GUANTANAMO AND 3,078 DIRECT REPATRIATIONS. THERE HAVE BEEN A TOTAL OF 10,511 MIGRANTS TRANSPORTED TO THE U.S. AND 410 MIGRANTS TRANSPORTED TO THIRD NATIONS. ONE HIV NEGATIVE MIGRANT WAS SCHEDULED TO MOVE TO CONUS ON 23 NOV TO JOIN COMMON LAW SPOUSE PREVIOUSLY MEDEVACED TO CONUS FOR CHILDBIRTH. (SEE DEPLOYED FORCES, PAGE B-4)

INDIAN OCEAN - CONTINUED(U) OPERATION PROVIDE RELIEF

- U.S. RELIEF FLIGHTS ARE PRESENTLY FLYING FROM MOMBASA TO WAJIR, KENYA AND TO BELET UEN, BAIDOA, ODDUR, WAAJID AND GIALALASSI, SOMALIA. AS OF 29 NOV, A TOTAL OF 1,370 MISSIONS HAVE BEEN FLOWN RESULTING IN THE MOVEMENT OF 16,165.68 METRIC TONS OF RELIEF SUPPLIES. MISSIONS FLOWN ON 24 NOV INCLUDED: 4 TO BELET UEN; 6 TO BAIDOA; 2 TO GIALALASSI AND 2 TO WAJIR. MISSIONS FLOWN ON 25 NOV INCLUDED: 4 TO BELET UEN; 5 TO BAIDOA; 2 TO ODDUR; 2 TO GIALALASSI AND 1 TO WAJIR. MISSIONS FLOWN ON 26 NOV INCLUDED: 5 TO BAIDOA AND 3 TO ODDUR. MISSIONS FLOWN ON 27 NOV INCLUDED: 4 TO BELET UEN; 8 TO BAIDOA; 1 TO GIALALASSI AND 1 TO WAJIR. MISSIONS FLOWN ON 28 NOV INCLUDED: 2 TO BELET UEN; 8 TO BAIDOA AND 2 TO ODDUR. MISSIONS FLOWN ON 29 NOV INCLUDED: 1 TO BELET UEN; 10 TO BAIDOA AND 1 TO WAJIR. MISSIONS SCHEDULED TO BE FLOWN ON 30 NOV INCLUDED: 1 TO BELET UEN; 10 TO BAIDOA AND 1 TO GIALALASSI. MISSIONS SCHEDULED FOR 1 DEC ARE TO BE DETERMINED.

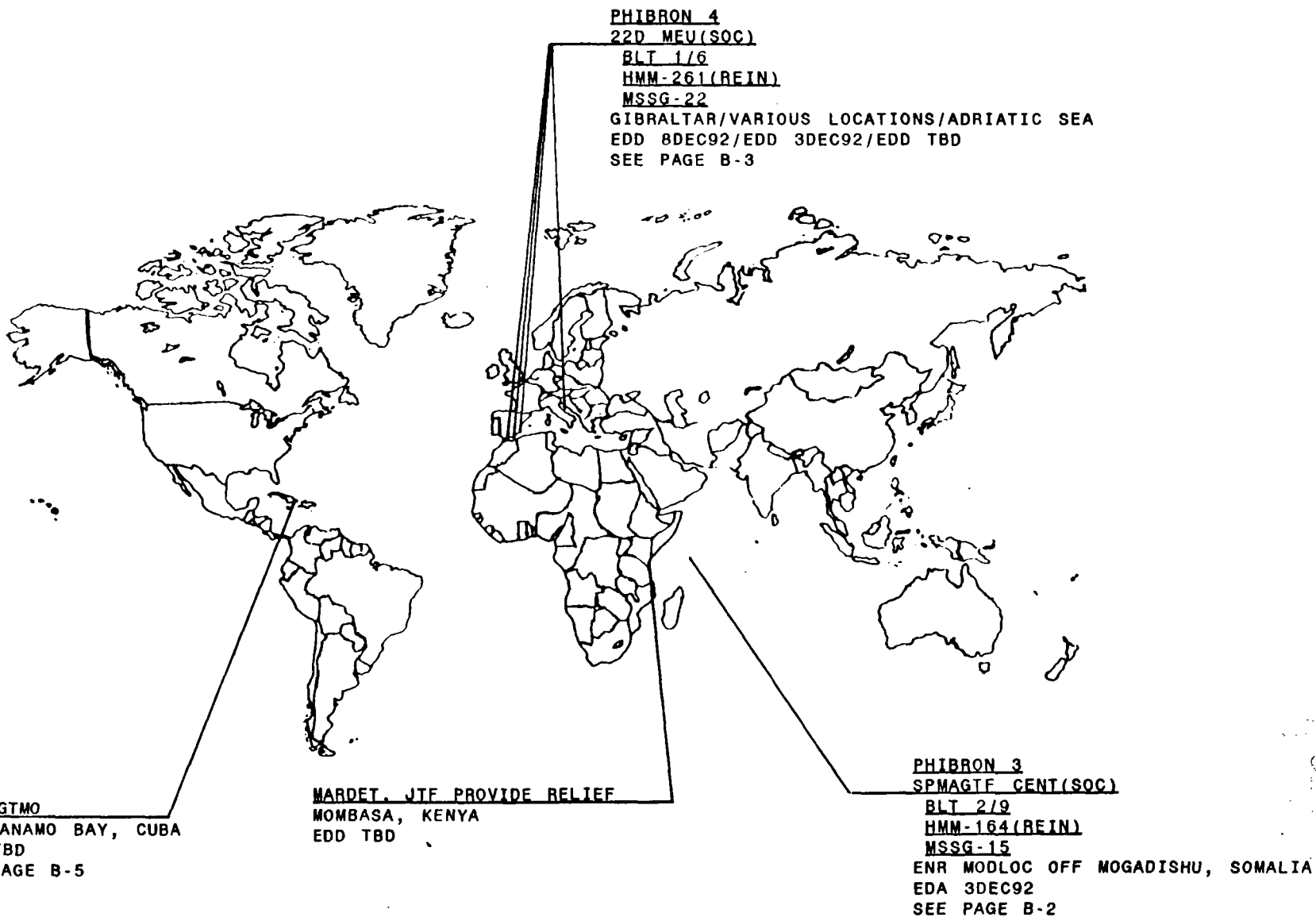
