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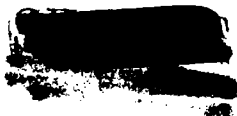

- INFORMATION CURRENT AS OF 291833Z DEC 92: - CURRENTLY THERE ARE 220 HIV(+) MIGRANTS AND 54 MEDICALLY CLEARED. OF THE 54 MEDICALLY CLEARED 53 ARE HIV FAMILY MEMBERS.

- THE MIGRANT STATUS AS OF 291833Z DEC 92 (SATURATION LEVELS SHOWN IN PARENTHESIS): 272 AT CAMP BULKELEY (1200) AND 2 AT THE GUANTANAMO BAY HOSPITAL. THERE ARE A TOTAL OF 274 HAITIANS AT GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA. 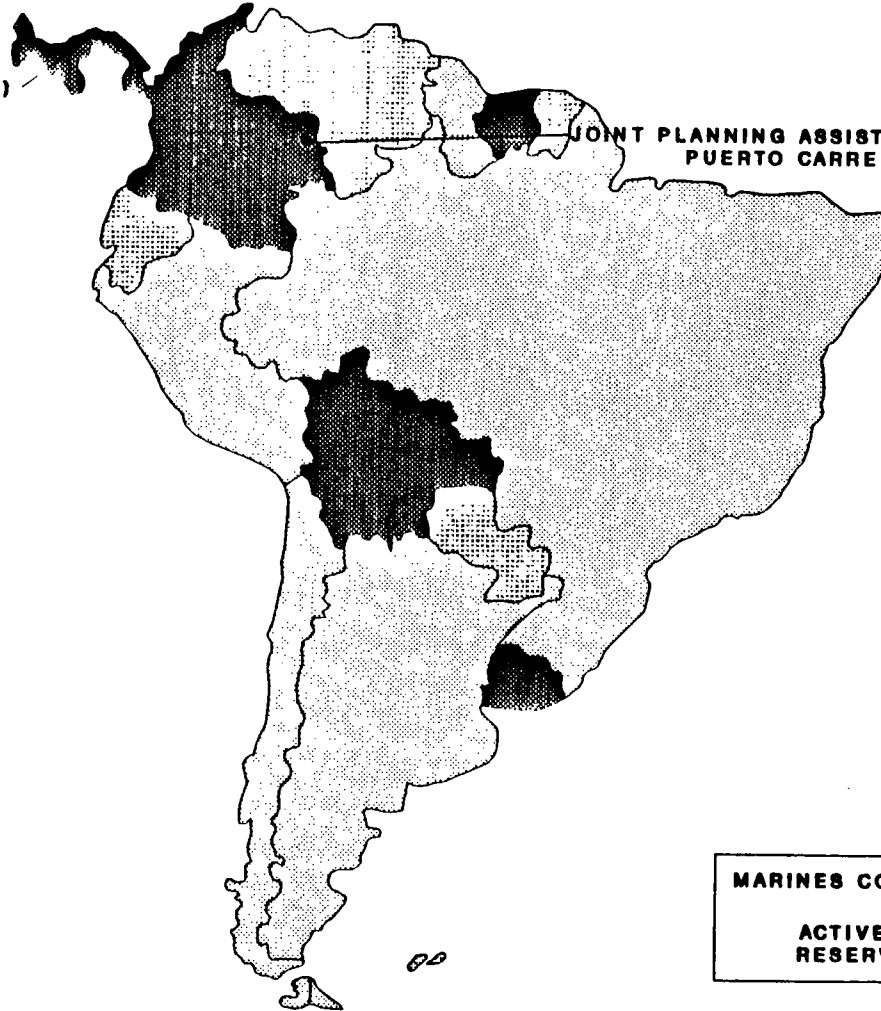
