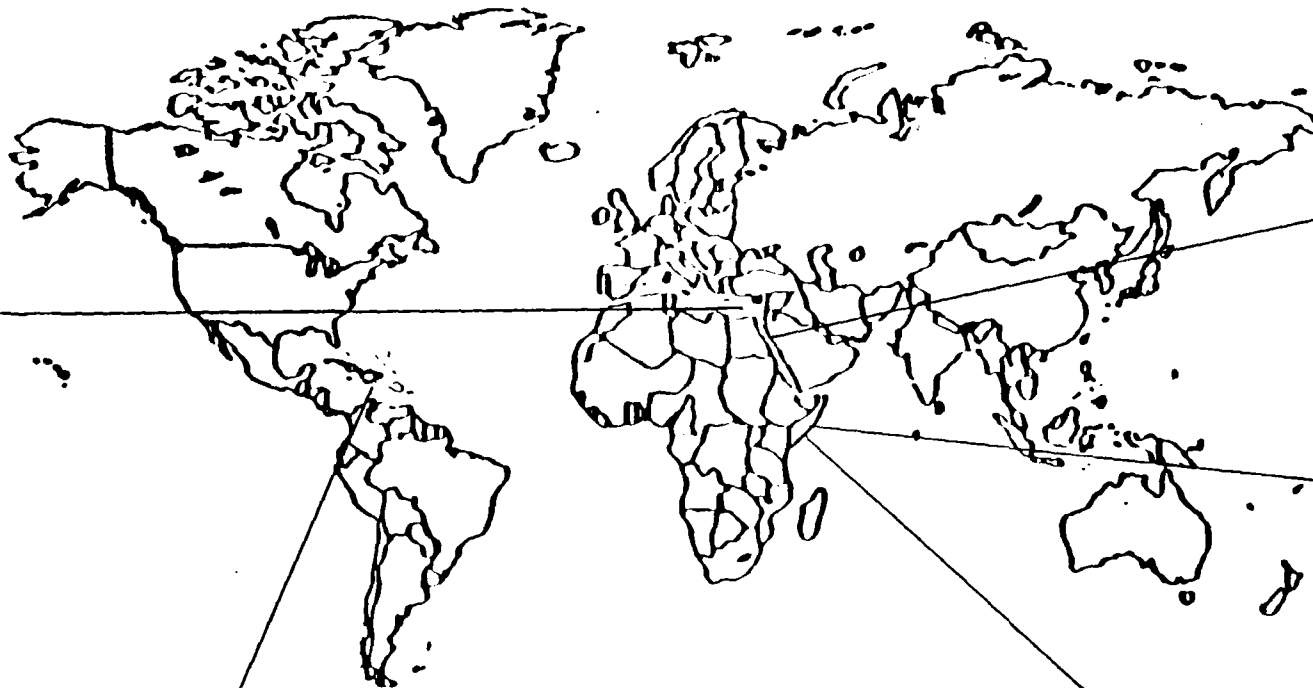

GENERAL

(C) TANDEM THRUST (1 - 31 Jul) is a USCINCPAC Joint Task Force (JTF) Headquarters field training exercise (FTX). - To coordinate en route assembly of JTF (air, surface, subsurface, amphibious, airborne, and ground elements).
- To provide expeditionary medical capability.

- To plan/provide communications zone support to deployed JTF.
