- COMMANDERS EVALUTION; THE ORGANIZED DEMONSTRATIONS HAVE ENDED AND THE SOMALIS ARE CLEARING ROADBLOCKS AND DEBRIS TO RESUME NORMAL COMMERCE. IT IS ILLUSTRATIVE THAT THE SOMALI POPULACE CAN BE SO EASILY AND EFFECTIVELY MANIPULATED BY AIDEED. THE LEAFLETS AND RADIO BROADCASTS COMMUNICATED A PREPOSTEROUS ALLEGATION WHICH WAS ACCEPTED WITHOUT QUESTION. I DOUBT WE HAVE SEEN THE END OF THIS TYPE OF ACTIVITY BY AIDEED AND WHILE IT HAS A DESTABILIZING EFFECT, IT IS TRANSITORY AND CAN BE DEALT WITH. IT DOES REFLECT THE EXTENT TO WHICH UNITAF OPERATIONS HAVE ERODED AIDEED'S BASE OF POWER AND HAVE CAUSED HIM TO RESORT TO RATHER DESPERATE EFFORTS TO DEMONSTRATE INFLUENCE IN THE AFFAIRS OF SOMALIA.

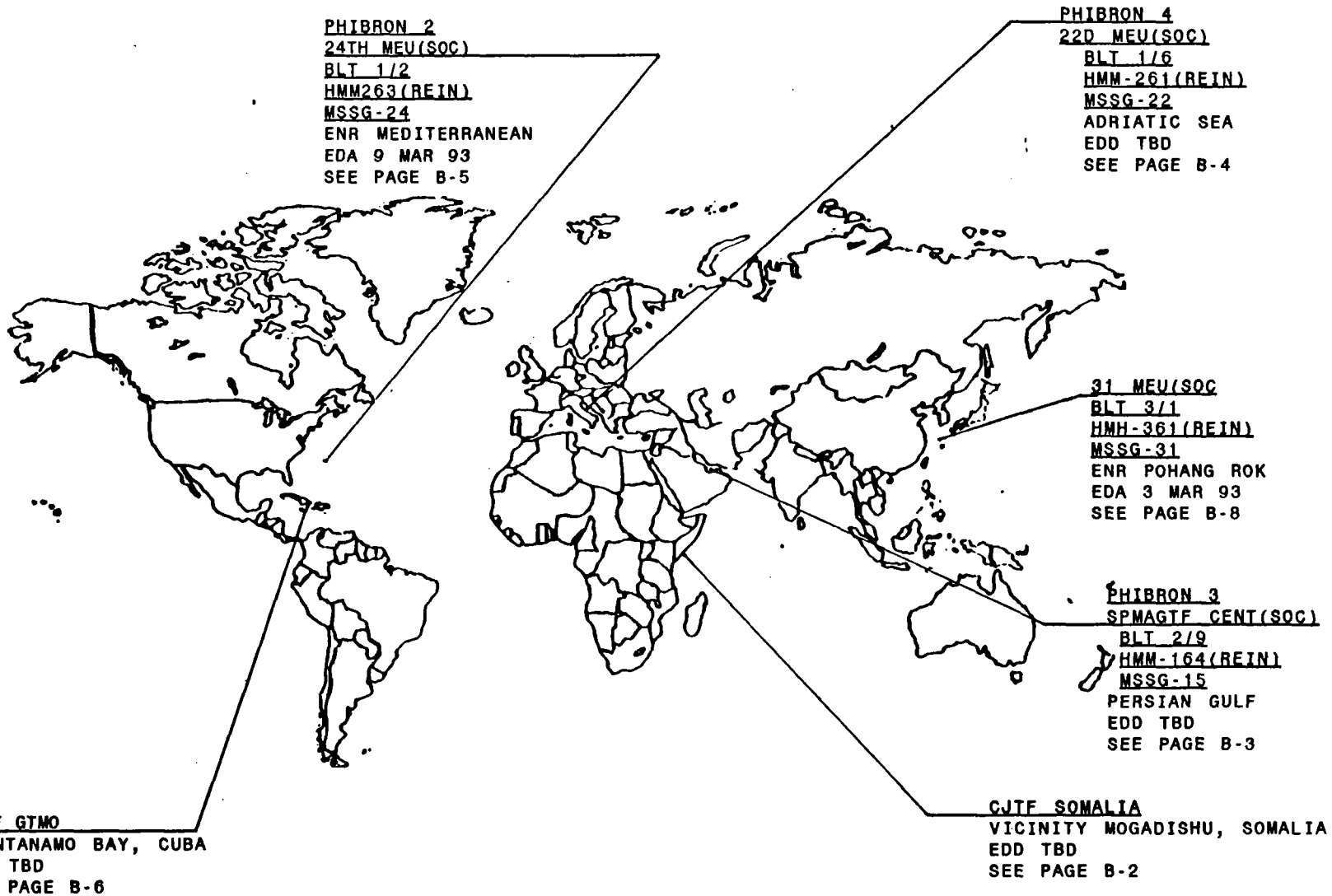

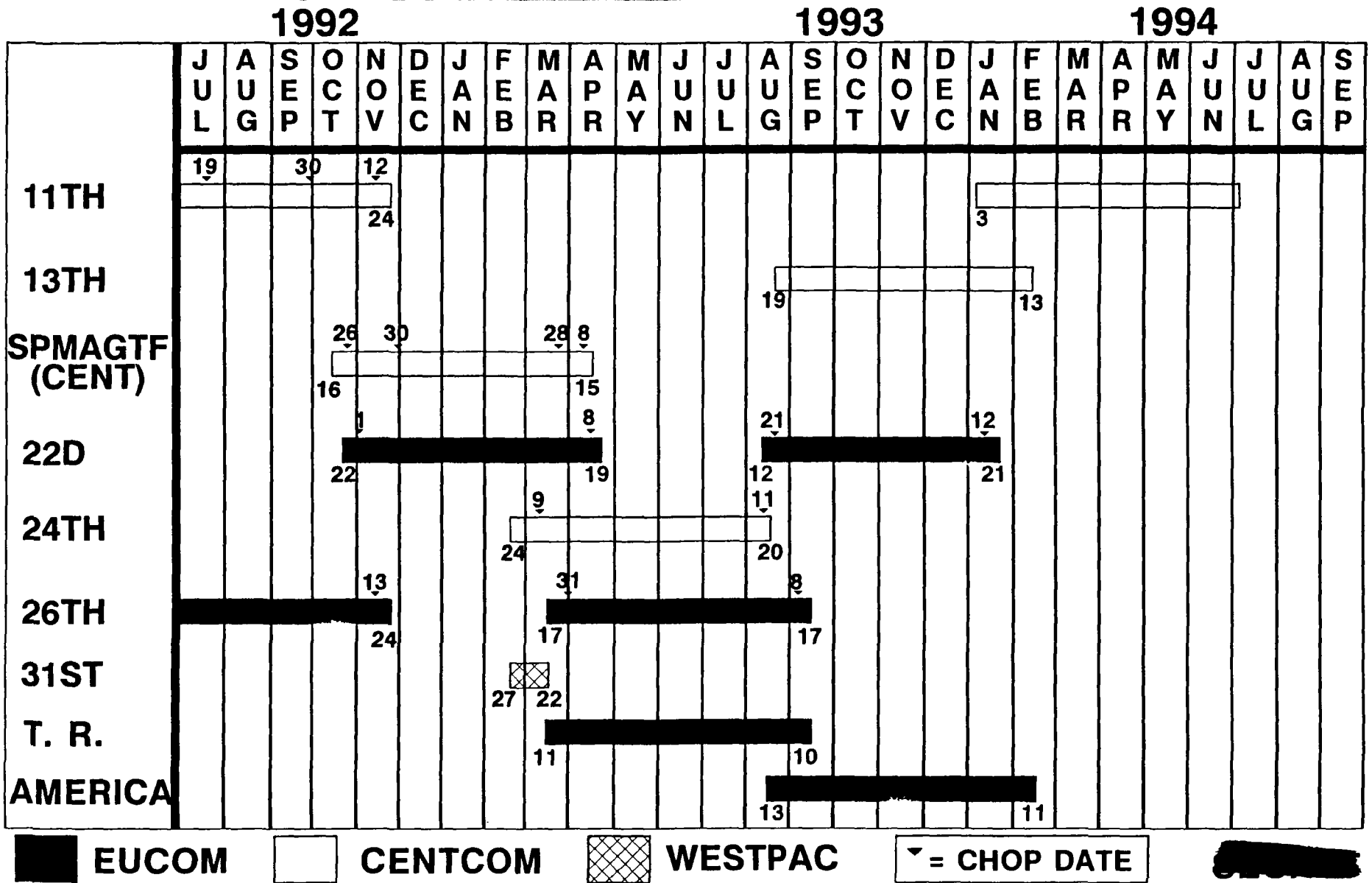
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MEU/SPMAGTF DEPLOYMENTS

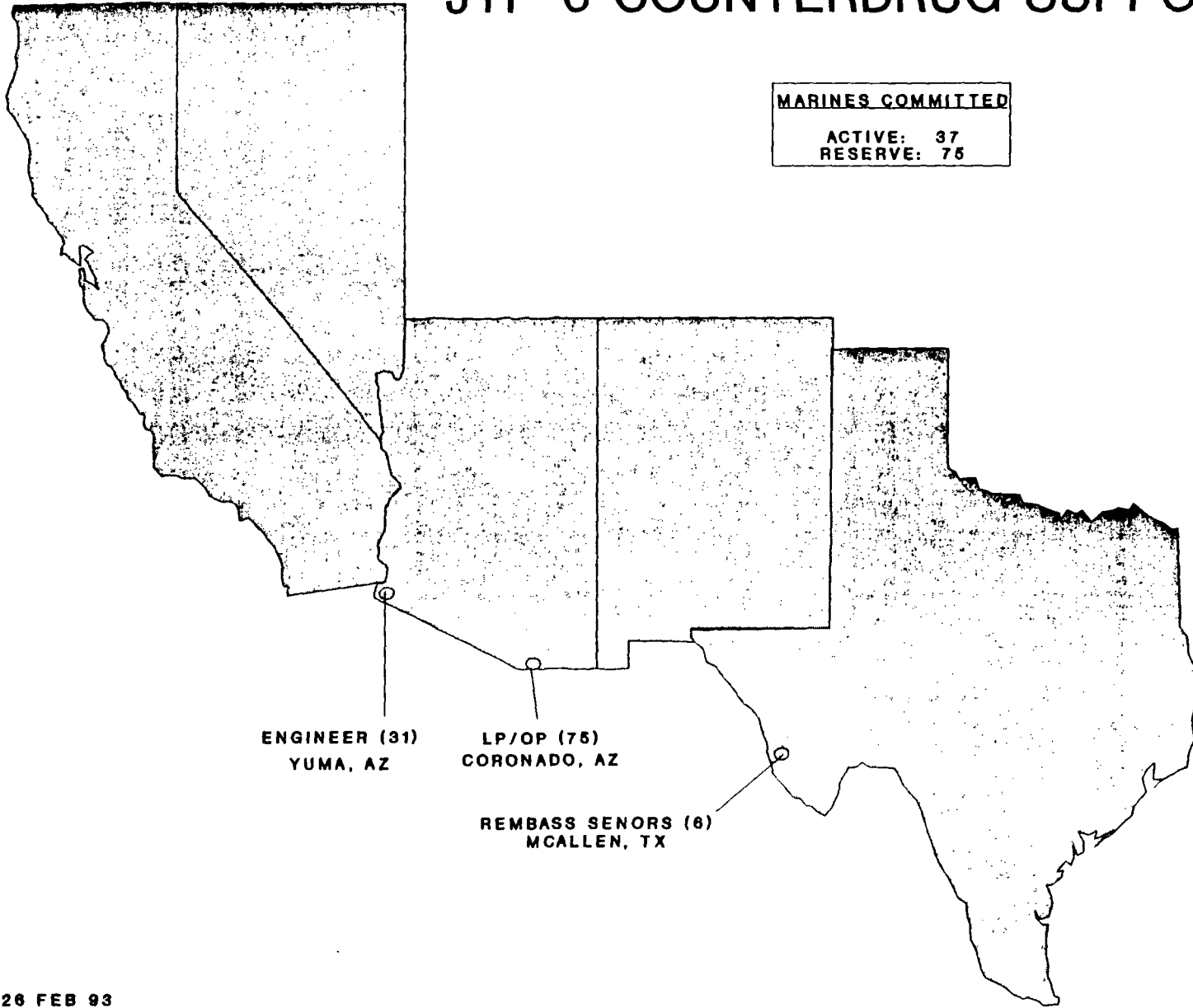

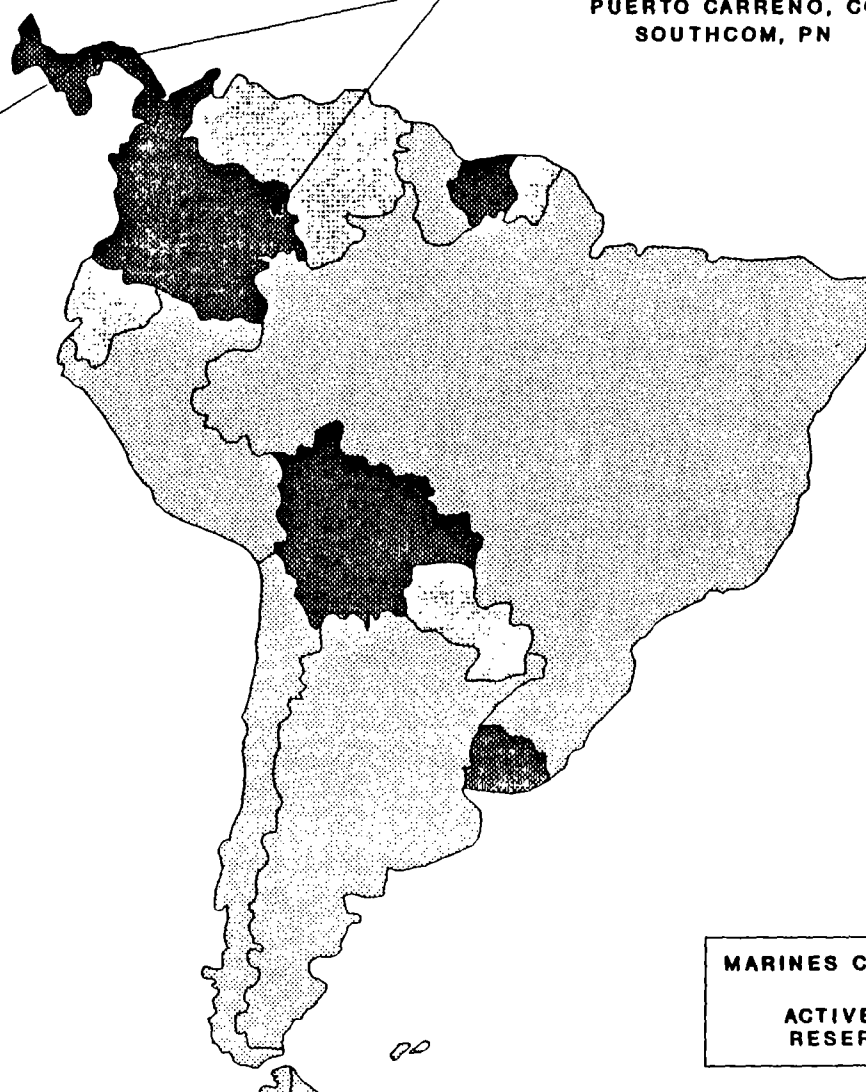
