

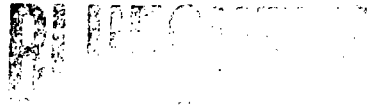

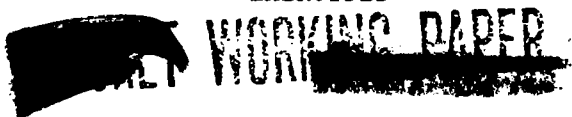

OCEAN VENTURE 93

GENERAL

(C) OCEAN VENTURE 93 (20 Apr - 25 May) is a USCINCLANT-sponsored joint field training exercise (FTX) to train USLANTCOM Headquarters, and Service Task Forces in rapid crisis action deployments and tactical operations. Joint ground, air, Maritime/Maritime Defense Zones and special operations will be exercised in support of a joint "contingency". The actual area of operations includes the Puerto Rico operations area, both ashore and at sea, as well as Florida, North Carolina, St Croix, Antigua, Grenada and Jamaica. The majority of the exercise will take place on military installations in Puerto Rico and in training areas/ airfields under the control of: Naval Station Roosevelt Roads, Atlantic Fleet Weapons Training Facility, Camp Santiago Avon Park, Florida and Camp Lejeune, NC. Foreign internal defense training will be conducted by Army and Navy special operations forces with the defense forces of Grenada and Jamaica.

PURPOSE

- (U) To train staffs and joint forces for combat contingency operations.
- (U) To exercise a joint task force (JTF), component task forces and the unified staff in planning and conducting joint operations using crisis action procedures.
- (U) To exercise/refine joint doctrine, tactics, techniques and procedures.
- (U) To evaluate USINCLANT's ability to execute elements of USCINCLANT CONPLAN 2100 and 2360.

POLITICAL-MILITARY SCENARIO

(C) The Ocean Venture 93 Scenario focuses on a fictitious Caribbean island nation known as "St Alexander". St Alexander is an Eastern Caribbean island which has been historically friendly to the United States. St Alexander is one of the poorest nations in the region and suffers from a weak economy and widespread poverty. Wealth and power is concentrated among a small elite class. The island's democratic system and economic prosperity have been seriously undermined by a series of military dictators.

EXERCISESPOLITICAL-MILITARY SCENARIO CONTINUATION

(C) In April 1991, the United Nations supervised elections brought a reform oriented president to power in St Alexander. However, the new government's platform of political, social, and economic reforms pose a threat to St Alexander's power elite. In response the right wing opposition, backed by senior military officers and financed by a prosperous drug cartel, begins a ruthless active measures campaign to discredit and destabilize the legitimately elected government. In Feb 93, the legitimate government is ousted in a military coup. The president escapes unharmed and requests U.S. support for restoration of the legitimate government.

(C) As tensions between the coup plotters and the U.S. Government increase, American citizens on St Alexander become targets for violence and harassment. As these incidents grow in frequency and severity, it becomes clear that the coup government does not intend to stop these attacks and in fact has directly supported them. In addition, the military leadership begins to expand its relationship with drug cartel kingpins and threatens to make St Alexander a major drug transshipment center. These factors will eventually lead to joint forcible entry operations, to restore order and place the legitimate government back in power.
