INFORMATION CURRENT AS OF 301800Z SEP 92CARIBBEAN(U) OPERATION GTMO

- INFORMATION CURRENT AS OF 282200Z SEP 92: - CURRENTLY THERE ARE 230 HIV(+) MIGRANTS AND 61 MEDICALLY CLEARED HIV FAMILY MEMBERS.

- THE MIGRANT STATUS AS OF 282200Z SEP 92 (SATURATION LEVELS SHOWN IN PARENTHESIS): 289 AT CAMP BULKELEY (1200), 1 AT THE GUANTANAMO BAY HOSPITAL AND 1 AT THE SEGREGATION FACILITY (20). THERE ARE A TOTAL OF 291 HAITIANS AT GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA. THROUGH 31 JAN 92, THERE WERE 955 MIGRANTS REPATRIATED TO HAITI (417 VOLUNTARY AND 538 INVOLUNTARY (PRIOR TO THE TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER)); SINCE 1 FEB 92, THERE HAVE BEEN 26,958 MIGRANTS REPATRIATED TO HAITI (23,880 FROM GUANTANAMO AND 3,078 DIRECT REPATRIATIONS. THERE HAVE BEEN A TOTAL OF 10,495 MIGRANTS TRANSPORTED TO THE U.S. AND 410 MIGRANTS TRANSPORTED TO THIRD NATIONS. (SEE DEPLOYED FORCES, PAGE B-5)

INDIAN OCEAN(S) 11TH MEU(SOC)

- 11TH MEU(SOC) AND PHIBRON 1, AS CENTCOM ARG 2-92, COMPLETED OPERATIONS OFF THE COAST OF SOMALIA IN SUPPORT OF THE TRANSPORT OF PAKISTANI FORCES. 11TH MEU(SOC) AND PHIBRON 1 WAS RELEASED TO COMSEVENTFLT AT 300001Z SEP BUT WILL REMAIN ON A 13 DAY TETHER TO USCENTCOM. 11TH MEU(SOC) AND PHIBRON 1 ARE STEAMING TO A 12 OCT ARRIVAL AT FREMANTLE, AUSTRALIA FOR PRE-BRIEFS PRIOR TO CONDUCTING EXERCISE VALIANT USHER 93-1, 13-19 OCT FOLLOWED BY A PORT VISIT AT PERTH, AUSTRALIA, 20-27 OCT. (SEE DEPLOYED FORCES, PAGE B-3 AND EXERCISES, PAGE E-4)

(S) TRANSPORT OF PAKISTANI FORCES

- THE LAST C-141 AIRLIFT OF THE PAKISTANI MAIN BODY ARRIVED AT MOGADISHU SOMALIA ON 29 SEP AND DEPARTED WITH THE COMBAT CONTROL TEAM (CCT) AND INJURED MARINE FOR THUMRAIT, OMAN. THE INJURED MARINE WILL BE TRANSPORTED TO BAHRAIN VIA C-130.

(S) OPERATION PROVIDE RELIEF

- U.S. RELIEF FLIGHTS ARE PRESENTLY FLYING FROM MOMBASA TO WAJIR, KENYA AND TO BAIDOA, ODDUR AND BARDERA, SOMALIA. AS OF 28 SEP, A TOTAL OF 387 MISSIONS HAVE BEEN FLOWN RESULTING IN THE MOVEMENT OF 4,761.96 METRIC TONS OF RELIEF SUPPLIES. MISSIONS SCHEDULED FOR 29 SEP INCLUDED: 11 TO BAIDOA; 3 TO WAJIR AND 4 TO ODDUR. MISSIONS SCHEDULED FOR 30 SEP INCLUDED: 11 TO BAIDOA; 2 TO WAJIR; 4 TO ODDUR AND THE FIRST RELIEF MISSION TO BARDERA. THE OPERATION IS EXPECTED TO LAST APPROXIMATELY 60 DAYS.

AN AMPHIBIOUS REHEARSAL IS SCHEDULED AT DOGANBEY, TURKEY ON TOMORROW AND SATURDAY WITH D-DAY AT SAROS BAY ON SUNDAY. BACKLOAD IS SCHEDULED FOR 9-10 OCT. - FLIGHTS INTO SPLIT, YUGOSLAVIA ENDED ON 19 SEP. OTHER MISSIONS REMAIN ON HOLD PENDING A SERIES OF U.N. HIGH COMMISSION ON REFUGEES (UNHCR) SPONSORED MEETINGS. THE SEARCH AND RESCUE (SAR) MISSION IS BEING FULFILLED BY A U.S. AIR FORCE SPECIAL OPERATIONS WING DETACHMENT LAND BASED AT AVAINO, ITALY. ELEMENTS OF 26TH MEU(SOC) ARE EXPECTED TO RESUME THE SAR MISSION AFTER EXERCISE DISPLAY DETERMINATION 92.
