



<u>Purpose</u>

To educate students on the elements of the MAGTF through the lens of the Single Battle Concept using our Maneuver Warfare Philosophy.

<u>Method</u>

Eight sub-courses within three rotations, consisting of C2, ISR, Fires, and Logistics as Rotation One; the Aviation Combat Element and Operations in the Information Environment as Rotation Two; and MAGTF in the Offense and MAGTF in the Defense as Rotation Three.


<u>Endstate</u>

EWS graduates will be able to integrate all warfighting functions and plan for the doctrinal employment of a combined arms MAGTF ashore through the use of expeditionary enablers to execute complex and distributed naval expeditionary operations.
