REDESIGNATED 1 AUGUST 1946 TO MARINE GROUND CONTROL INTERCEPT SQUADRON 4
AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE AIR CONTROL GROUP 2

DEACTIVATED 30 APRIL 1947

REACTIVATED 30 JUNE 1951 AT SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA, AND ASSIGNED TO MARINE AIR CONTROL GROUP 3

REDESIGNATED 15 FEBRUARY 1954 AS MARINE AIR CONTROL SQUADRON 4

RELOCATED DURING JULY 1959 TO IWAKUNI, JAPAN, AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE WING HEADQUARTERS GROUP, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

RELOCATED DURING OCTOBER 1960 TO SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA, AND REASSIGNED TO 3D MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

DEPLOYED DURING JUNE 1967 TO DA NANG, REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM, AND REASSIGNED TO 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

REASSIGNED DURING AUGUST 1967 TO MARINE AIR CONTROL GROUP 18


