REDEPLOYED DURING JUNE 1965 TO IWAKUNI, JAPAN, AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 13, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

REDEPLOYED DURING DECEMBER 1965 TO DA NANG, REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM, AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 11, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

RELOCATED DURING AUGUST 1974 TO BEAUFORT, SOUTH CAROLINA, AND REASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 31, 2D MARINE AIRCRAFT WING
