RELOCATED DURING AUGUST 1944 TO VERO BEACH, FLORIDA

RELOCATED DURING JULY 1945 TO SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA, AND ASSIGNED  
TO MARINE FLEET AIR, WEST COAST

RELOCATED DURING JANUARY 1946 TO SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA, AND ASSIGNED TO  
MARINE AIR SUPPORT GROUP 46, MARINE AIR, WEST COAST

REDESIGNATED 1 AUGUST 1946 TO MARINE GROUND CONTROL INTERCEPT SQUADRON 4 AND  
ASSIGNED TO MARINE AIR CONTROL GROUP 2, MARINE AIR, WEST COAST

DEACTIVATED 30 APRIL 1947

1951 – 1963

REACTIVATED 30 JUNE 1951 AT SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA, AND ASSIGNED TO  
MARINE AIR CONTROL GROUP 3, AIR FLEET MARINE FORCE, PACIFIC

REDESIGNATED 15 FEBRUARY 1954 AS MARINE AIR CONTROL SQUADRON 4

RELOCATED DURING JULY 1959 TO IWAKUNI, JAPAN, AND ASSIGNED TO MARINE WING HEADQUARTERS GROUP,  
1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

RELOCATED DURING OCTOBER 1960 TO SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA, AND ASSIGNED TO  
3D MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

RELOCATED DURING SEPTEMBER 1961 TO IWAKUNI, JAPAN, AND ASSIGNED TO  
1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

DEPLOYED TO THAILAND DURING MAY-JULY 1962 IN CONNECTION WITH COMMUNIST THREAT TO THAT COUNTRY

RELOCATED DURING OCTOBER 1962 TO SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA, AND ASSIGNED TO  
3D MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

RELOCATED DURING OCTOBER 1963 TO IWAKUNI, JAPAN, AND ASSIGNED TO  
1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

1964 – 1975

RELOCATED DURING OCTOBER 1964 TO SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA, AND ASSIGNED TO  
3D MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

RELOCATED DURING OCTOBER 1965 TO CAMP PENDLETON, CALIFORNIA

DEPLOYED DURING JUNE 1967 TO DA NANG, REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM, AND ASSIGNED TO  
1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

REASSIGNED DURING AUGUST 1967 TO MARINE AIR CONTROL GROUP 18,  
1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

PARTICIPATED IN THE WAR IN VIETNAM, JUNE 1967 – JANUARY 1971, OPERATING FROM  
DA NANG

RELOCATED DURING JANUARY 1971 TO SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA

DEACTIVATED 31 JANUARY 1971

REACTIVATED 15 JUNE 1971 AT FUTEMA, OKINAWA, JAPAN, AND ASSIGNED TO  
MARINE AIR CONTROL GROUP 18, 1ST MARINE AIRCRAFT WING

1976 – 2005


DURING MARCH 1976 FUTEMA, OKINAWA REDESIGNATED AS FUTENMA, OKINAWA
