DEPLOYED DURING MARCH 1942 TO EFATE, NEW HEBRIDES

RELOCATED DURING JUNE 1942 TO SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA

REDESIGNATED 1 JULY 1942 AS HEADQUARTERS SQUADRON 24

DEPLOYED DURING FEBRUARY 1943 TO EWA, OAHU, TERRITORY OF HAWAII, AND
REASSIGNED TO 4TH MARINE BASE DEFENSE AIRCRAFT WING


