REACTIVATED 1 JULY 1962 AT DALLAS, TEXAS, AND ASSIGNED TO MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 41,  
4TH MARINE AIRCRAFT WING, U.S. MARINE CORPS RESERVE

REDESIGNATED 27 JANUARY 1989 AS MARINE AVIATION LOGISTICS SQUADRON 41


PARTICIPATED IN SUPPORT OF OPERATIONS DESERT SHIELD AND DESERT STORM, SOUTHWEST ASIA,


