1976 – 2004

REASSIGNED 1 JANUARY 1976 AND PLACED UNDER THE OPERATIONAL CONTROL OF THE 2D MARINE DIVISION

DETACHED 1 MARCH 1976 FROM FORCE TROOPS, FLEET MARINE FORCE, ATLANTIC, AND ASSIGNED TO THE
2D MARINE DIVISION

PARTICIPATED IN OPERATIONS DESERT SHIELD AND DESERT STORM, SOUTHWEST ASIA, JANUARY-APRIL 1991
