RELOCATED DURING NOVEMBER 1920 TO MARINE BARRACKS, WASHINGTON, D.C.

DURING DECEMBER 1977, OPERATIONAL CONTROL OF THE MARINE CORPS INSTITUTE WAS TRANSFERRED
FROM DIRECTOR OF TRAINING, HEADQUARTERS, U.S. MARINE CORPS, TO COMMANDING GENERAL,
MARINE CORPS DEVELOPMENT AND EDUCATION COMMAND, QUANTICO, VIRGINIA

DURING OCTOBER 1980, THE MARINE CORPS INSTITUTE AND THE MARINE CORPS EXTENSION SCHOOL,
QUANTICO, VIRGINIA, WERE CONSOLIDATED AT THE MARINE CORPS INTSTITUTE,
MARINE BARRACKS, WASHINGTON, D.C.
