

CAMP LEJEUNE SNCO ACADEMY UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

SERGEANTS COURSE

1. Uniform of the day is typically the seasonal service uniform. Students are required to have serviceable MARPAT Utilities for conduct of Drill and Field exercises and inclement weather.
2. Students will receive personnel inspections in all uniform items for serviceability and fit.
3. PT is conducted in various types of uniforms.
4. Students will attend a Mess Night (Blue Dress "A" or "B")
5. Field training may be conducted.
6. Uniform policies vary by location; contact your Academy for clarification.
7. Students are required to dress in "professional attire" for presentations. This will encompass dress pants/slacks, a collared shirt and tie, and belt for males. Females have the option of either: a dress, skirt and blouse, or blouse with pants/slacks. All attire/hair must be work in accordance with MCO P1020.34G w/ch 1-5.

CAREER COURSE

1. Uniform of the day is typically the seasonal service uniform. Students are required to have serviceable MARPAT Utilities in the case of inclement weather.
2. PT is conducted in various types of uniforms.
3. Students will attend a Mess Night or Dining In. (Blue Dress "A" or "B").

5. All SNCOs are required to wear white trousers with the Dress Blue "A" or "B" uniform during summer uniform season.

ADVANCED COURSE

1. Uniform of the day is typically the seasonal service uniform. Students are required to have serviceable MARPAT Utilities in the case of inclement weather.
2. PT is conducted in various types of uniforms.
3. Students will attend a Professional Dinner. (Suit and Tie required for wear). Female Students may wear a pants suit or dress.
4. Uniform policies vary by location; contact your Academy for clarification.
5. All SNCOs are required to wear white trousers with the Dress Blue "A" and "B" uniform during summer uniform season.

ALL COURSES

1. Occasionally, the courses conduct training in civilian attire. In accordance with paragraph 1005.7.d. of MCO P1020.34G w/ch 1-5 (web), students should bring at least one set of "appropriate civilian attire." Refer to paragraph 1005.7.d of MCO P1020.34G w/ch 1-5.
2. Computer assets vary by local academy, students are highly encouraged to bring a laptop and a government-procured USB external hard drive with current Guardian Edge Removable Device software pre-installed. USB flash drives (thumb-drives) are no longer authorized on NMCI networks.
3. All students are required to have a reflective belt for wear during PT.
4. All students must have green nylon PT shorts (spandex cannot be seen), and PT socks without logos.
5. Sweats are required, running suits will not be utilized while in attendance.
